



Shrewsbury ASC Code of Conduct for Parents

Parents are expected to:

1. Complete and return all the forms in the Membership Pack.
2. Ensure that Shrewsbury ASC is always kept up-to-date with any changes including medical and contact details.
3. Deliver and collect your child promptly at the beginning and end of training sessions and competitions.
4. Ensure your child has the correct equipment and clothing with them for training sessions.
5. Inform the Coach if your child needs to leave a training session early.
6. Inform the Coach of details if your child is being collected by someone different to usual.
7. Encourage your child to obey rules, to understand the need for good behaviour at all times, especially in the changing rooms.
8. Behave responsibly as a spectator at training sessions and competitions.
9. Treat everyone, swimmers, coaches, volunteers and officials with due respect.
10. Ensure you do not use inappropriate language within the club environment. This includes at training sessions, outside in the car park, away at competition, on hired transport to and from competitions etc.
11. Show appreciation and support all the Shrewsbury ASC team members.
12. Ensure your child's needs are met in terms of nutritional needs and listen to advice given from the Coach.
13. Support the club's Coach and committee appropriately and raise any concerns you may have in an appropriate manner.
14. Do not enter poolside unless requested to do so or in an emergency. If you wish to discuss anything with the Coach, this must be at a convenient time before or after the training session, not during the session.

15. Help your child to enjoy the sport and to achieve to the best of their ability. Do not have unrealistic expectations of your child or put undue pressure on them to succeed. Remember, they will be doing their best!

Shrewsbury ASC will undertake to:

1. Inform you as soon as possible if your child becomes ill and ensure their wellbeing until you are able to be present.
2. Ensure good child safeguarding guidelines (following ASA procedures) are followed at all times to keep your child safe.
3. Ensure all activities are properly supervised, taught, coached and that consent is obtained for any activity outside of that previously agreed.

The parent has a right to:

1. Make a complaint to Shrewsbury ASC if they feel that a member of the Club is not acting according to ASA or Shrewsbury ASC rules and regulations.
2. Make a complaint on behalf of their child to the ASA Office of Judicial Administration.
